## **Baby At The Park**

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005

**CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required** 

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, both hands on stroller, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

**SCENARIO:** After giving up on camping, you and your significant other decide to stay close to home and take a walk in the park. It's been an eventful weekend. Don't let your guard down though; the weekend is not over. The last members of the gang find you, and want revenge for what you did to their brothers. Take care of business again, but beware of the friendlies in the park.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** At the start signal, push the stroller to P2 behind cover. Draw and engage T1-T7 and the poppers from cover. Be sure to keep the stroller and the baby behind cover as well.


- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload.
- Be sure to use cover appropriately.

IDPA Match - May 22, 2010

- T6 is flips up when the popper is knocked down. Failure to know down the activator popper is a -5, FTN, -10 (T6), & FTN (T6).
- Rough handling of the stroller or failure to keep the stroller behind cover will result in a procedural penalty.

**SCORING:** Vickers Count **RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads **ROUND COUNT:** 16 Minimum **START-STOP:** Audible and last shot

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 shots on T1-T7 and knock down steel
